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EASTERN ADRIATIC COAST - KARSTIC LANDSCAPE

- Karst is a topography formed from the dissolution of soluble rocks – limestone (leaving it exposed on surface or covered with soil)
- It is characterized by underground drainage systems with sinkholes and caves
- Many karst-related terms derive from South Slavic languages, entering scientific vocabulary through early research in the Western Balkan Dinaric Alpine karst – polje, doline

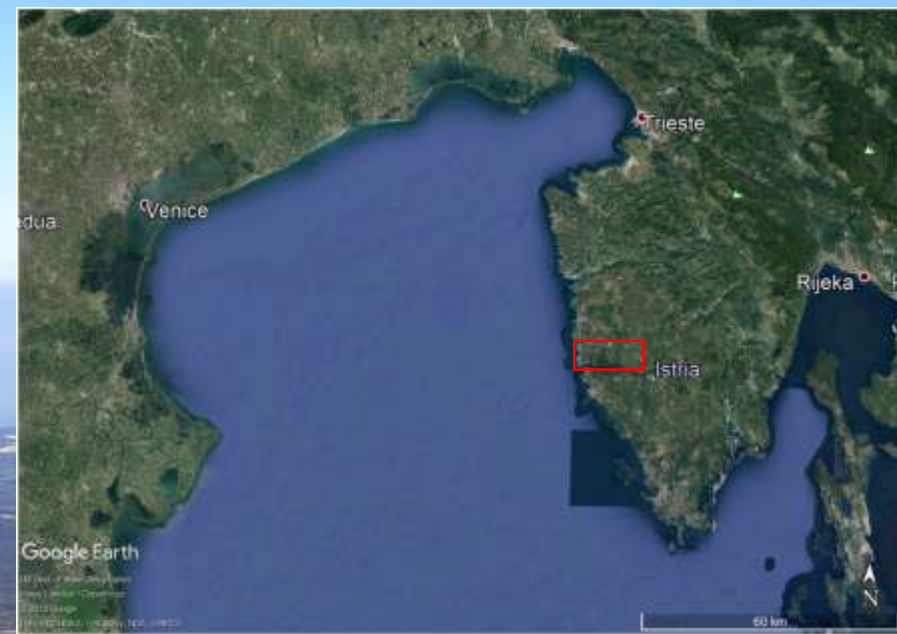

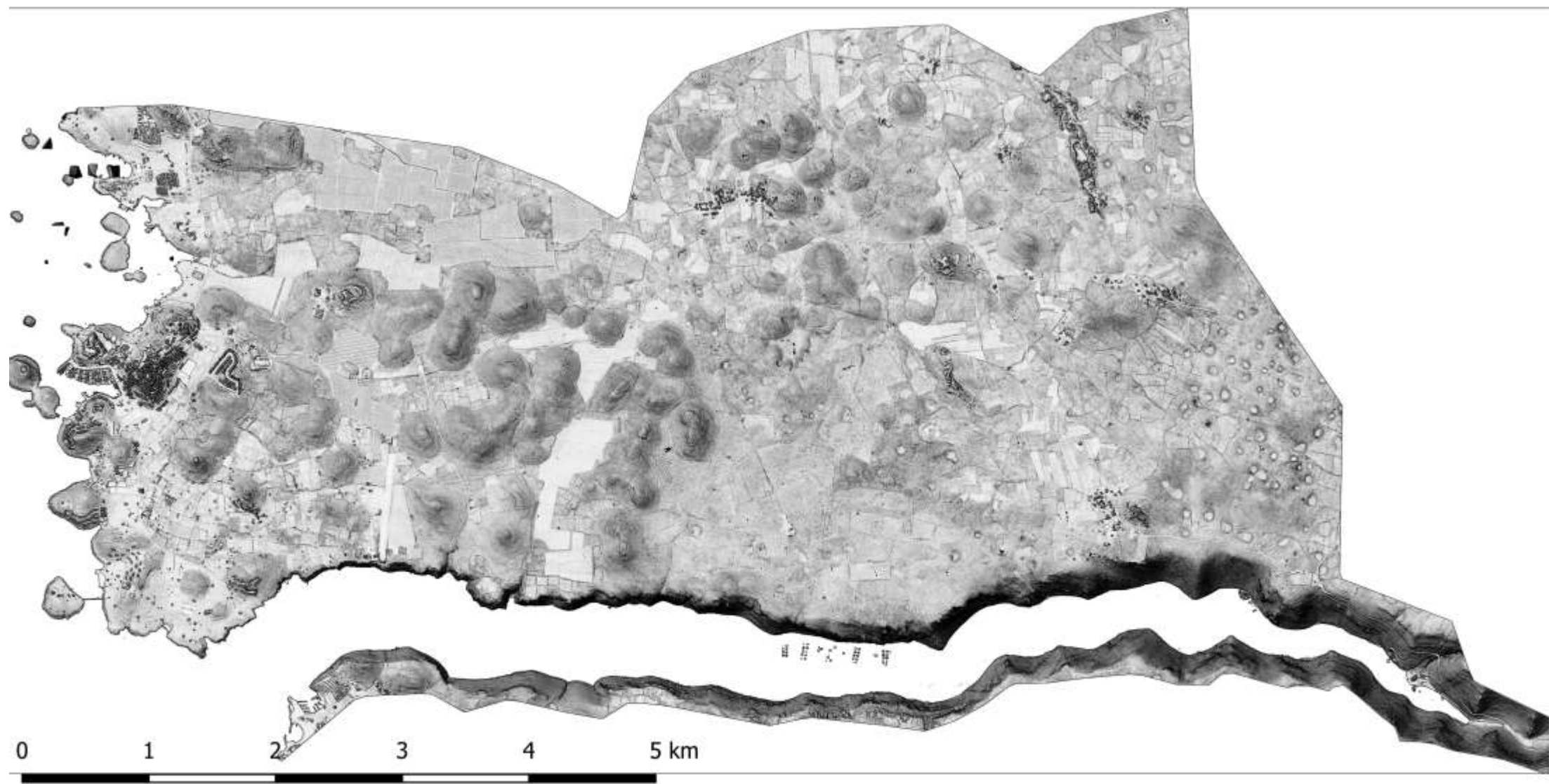

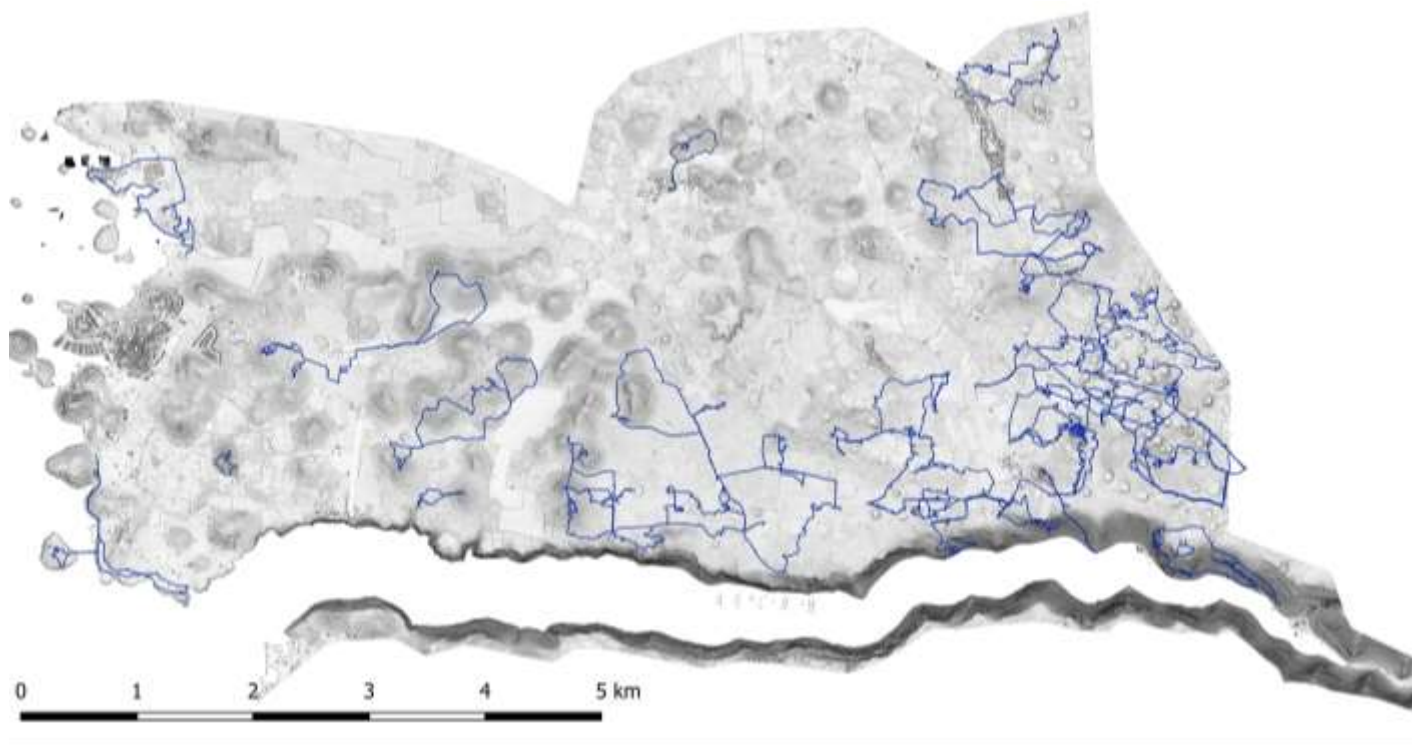

OBJECTIVES:

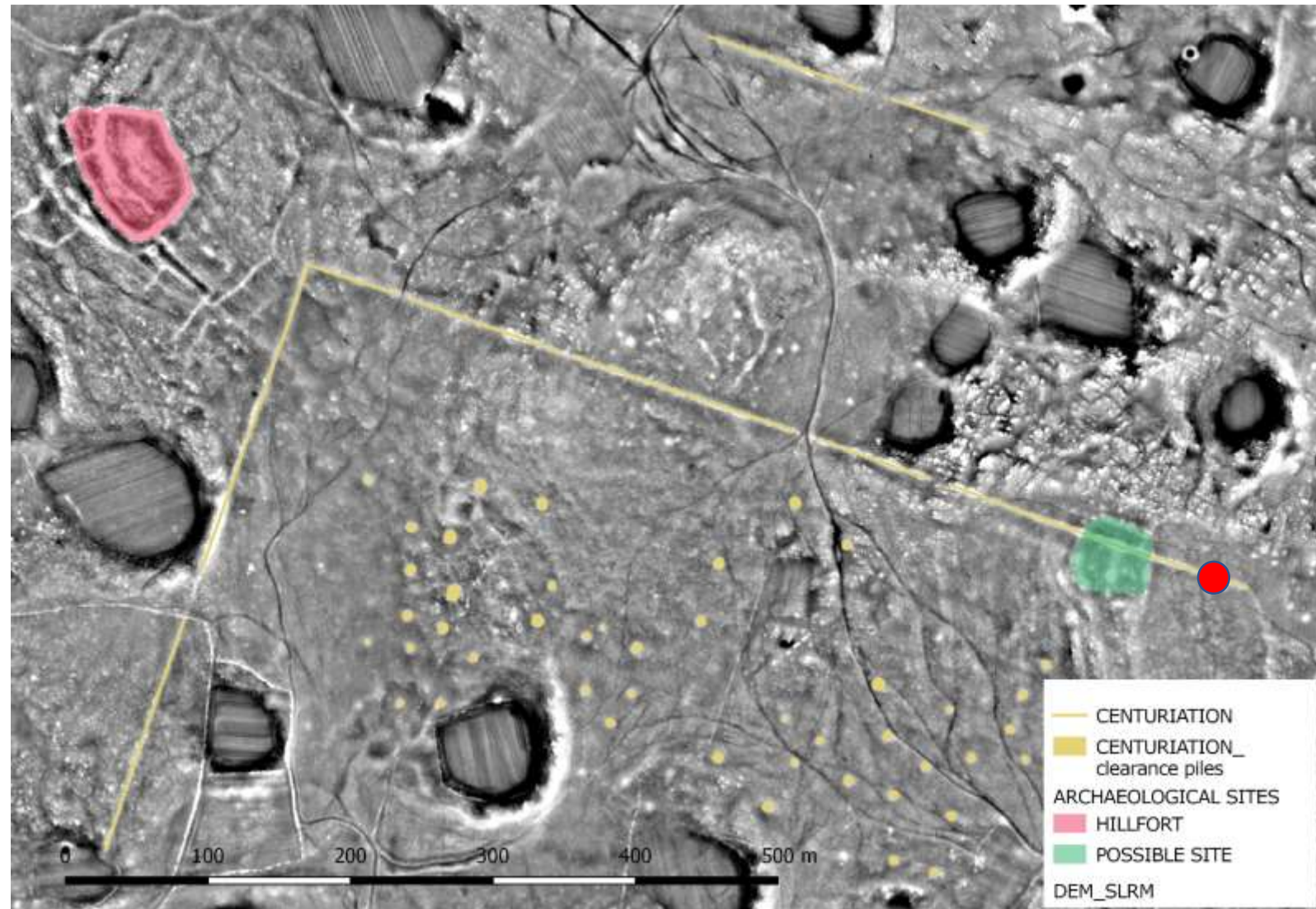
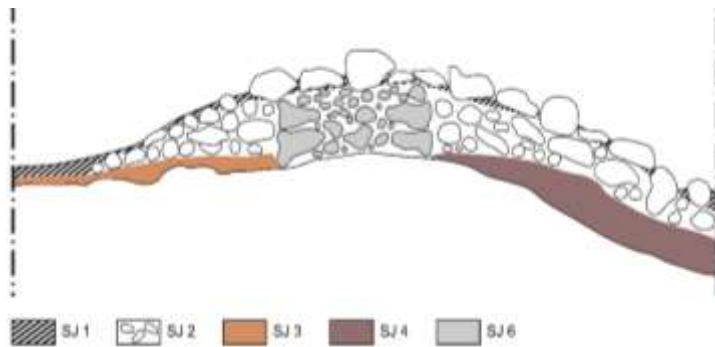
- Identification of archaeological features and research of historical landscape

- Preparation of selected sites for presentation.

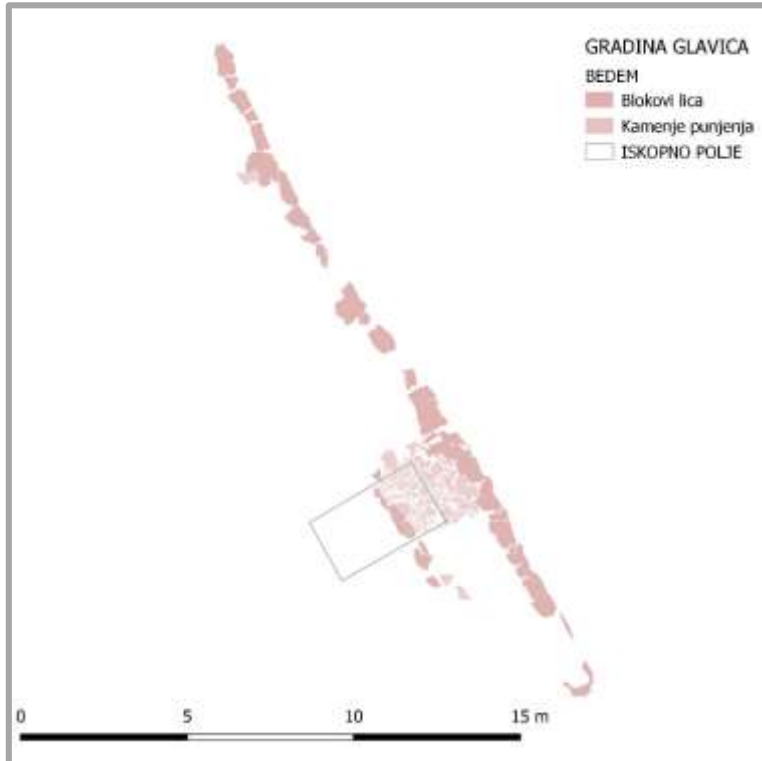
